Invitation to Bid

The Rich Mountain Conservation District is soliciting proposals for the sale of the Tye No-Till Grain Drill, approximately 4,742 acres planted. Sealed bids will be received in the office at 508 7th Street Mena AR 71953 no later than the date and time set forth below.

Proposals must be executed in accordance with and subject to instructions and specifications set herein.

Standard Instructions

These instructions are standard for all proposals for the purchase of all supplies, materials, and equipment. The Board of Directors may delete, supersede, or modify any of these standard instructions for a particular proposal by indicating such change in the selection headed "Special Instructions to Bidders".

1. No proposal may be withdrawn for a period of thirty (30) days following the opening of the proposals without consent of the RMCD Board of Directors.
2. The equipment is located at 508 7th Street Mena AR 71953.
3. All equipment sold as is. Equipment must be removed from site within ten (10) days of bid award at the bidder's expense.

Special Instructions To Bidders - Supplies, Materials & Equipment

1. The attached proposal is signed by the bidder with full knowledge of and agreement with, the general specifications, conditions, and requirements of this bid.
2. Return proposal in a sealed envelope.
3. Submit proposal in an envelope marked with the bidder's name and address in the upper left-hand corner.
4. Bids should be addressed to: Cynthia Mateu, Business Administrator, 508 7th Street Mena AR 71953 with bid due date of September 6, 2024 by 4:00 p.m.

Clearly mark envelope with the title of the bid "Invitation to Tye No-Till Grain Drill"

5. Bids received later than time specified will not be considered. Amendments to, or withdrawals of bids received later than the time and date set for bid opening will not be considered.
6. Bidders may be present at opening of bids.
7. The Board of Directors reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive technical defects and to make awards by item or total as may be in the best interest of the Board of Directors.
8. Successful bidders will be notified within five working days. Prior to removing equipment, bidders must submit a cashier's or certified check for the total amount bid on the items. Cash is also acceptable.
